One of the best aspects of Discord is its variety of features to have a fun and engaging discussion. This includes support for emotes, emoji reactions, GIF support, and stickers. The last one is my personal favorite and if you wish to try them out, or create your own stickers to add some fun ways to interact on your Discord server, then you've come to the right place. In this article, we discuss everything you need to know about how to create and use Discord stickers. In 2021, Discord added sticker support to its messaging platform. Discord Stickers (not to be confused with Discord emojis) are available as static as well as animated. Server owners can add 5 custom stickers to their server for free. If you want more, you will need at least two boosts, which unlocks Level 1. This gives you access to 10 more sticker slots, giving a total of 15 stickers. Level 2 and Level 3 servers have 30 and 60 sticker slots, respectively. To add or remove custom stickers in a Discord server, you will need to have the Manage emojis and stickers permission. It's worth noting that server members can use stickers even if they don't have a Discord Nitro subscription. Below, we have mentioned the prerequisites for creating a sticker for your Discord server. Pick an image you want to use as a sticker. Next, crop the image in a 1:1 ratio with any photo editing software. I am using Photoshop. Now resize its dimensions to 320 x 320 pixels resolution. Finally, save the image as a PNG file. Now your sticker is ready to be uploaded to Discord. Alternatively, you can use the Kapwing online editor to make your Discord sticker. Much like the companys Discord emoji maker, Kapwing has a template to resize your image and add text or change the background colors if you like. The template is already set to 320 x 320 resolution, and you just need to upload your image to get started. Check Kapwing Discord Sticker Template Now that you have your custom sticker ready, its time to upload it to your Discord server. Note that, this can only be done via Discords website or desktop app. Heres how you can do this. Open your Discord server and click on the server name at the top left. From the list of options that appear now, select Server Settings.Choose Stickers from the left sidebar of the server settings page.Click on the Upload Sticker button. If you wish to upload more, you will need to spend \$9.99 to get 2 server boosts and unlock Level 1 perks, which allow you to upload 10 more stickers.Click on the Browse option and choose the Discord stickers PNG file. Now set its name, and related emoji, and add a description. Note that Discord suggests your sticker to server members when they type the assigned emoji, so choose wisely. Then click on the Upload button.Now, all the members can start using the sticker you added to the server. If an uploaded sticker becomes outdated, or youre running out of slots, then you can remove stickers from your Discord server. Just follow these steps: Open your Discord server and click on its name from the top-left corner. Click on Server Settings from the drop-down menu.Switch to the Stickers tab from the left sidebar to access the stickers page. You will see all the stickers you have uploaded to the server so far. Hover your cursor over the stickers you wish to remove and click the red cross X button. This will remove said sticker, and offer you use the slot for other stickers. Once a sticker is removed, your server members wont be able to access it any longer. Any emojis assigned to it will reset. As mentioned above, Discord still doesnt feature the option to upload or create stickers via the smartphone app. However, you can use NON, one of the popular Discord bots that offer Nitro perks for free. It also has an option that lets you send stickers with predetermined keywords. If you do not know how to invite a bot, learn how to add Discord bots to your server before you proceed. To do this, invite the NQN bot (website) to your Discord server. Now click the plus icon and select the image you wish to use. Then type the!sticker create command and tap on the Send button.This will add the image as a sticker, and others can use .file_name: to access it. However, it wont show up in the stickers section of the app. To rename the sticker, use the!sticker rename old_name new_name command.Although not as ubiquitous as Discord emojis, stickers are gradually finding a place of their own in chats. However, the server will have to be on Level 3 (14 boosts) to unlock all those slots. Meanwhile, Level 1 servers have 15 slots and Level 2 servers have 30 slots. How can I add stickers to the Discord mobile app? The option to add or remove stickers is not available on Discord mobile at the moment. You will have to use Discords desktop or web app to manage stickers. How to use stickers on Discord without Nitro subscription? Discord lets you upload five stickers to your servers without any server boosts. But to add more, you need to unlock at Level 1 perks. Besides, you could use bots like NQN and Sticker Surge to use stickers on servers without Nitro. What are the requirements for creating Discord stickers? To create a Discord sticker, you need a PNG image that is cropped in 1:1 square format. It needs to be 320 x 320 pixels in dimensions. In order to upload a sticker to Discord, youll need to either own a Discord server or be a moderator of a server with the Manage Expressions permission.If youve got the power to upload stickers, head into Server Settings > Stickers! Here, youll find a menu that looks just like the screenshot below that shows how many sticker slots you have available, any stickers you already have uploaded to the server, and even the server moderator who uploaded it.When uploading a sticker, youll need to keep in mind these upload requirements:Image resolution: 320x320 exactSupported image formats: PNG for static stickers, APNG or GIF for animated stickersFile size limit: 512 KB maxAssociated Emoji: Choose an emoji most similar to your sticker. This lets any stickers show up in places like sticker suggestions or search, making them easier to find and use.(Optional) Text description: Help those using screen readers understand what your sticker represents and help make your stickers accessible and enjoyable by everyone.Once youve got all this filled out, just hit Upload and youre done! Now, everyone in your server will be able to enjoy your sticker. And if someone has Nitro, theyll even be able to use your sticker in outside servers and conversations! Oh, the places your creation will go!Every Discord server can add up to five stickers to start. If youd like to upload more stickers to your server, youll need to use Server Boosting to access more sticker slots.Depending on how boosted your server is, you can upload 5, 15, 30, or 60 stickers total! The chart above shows how many stickers each level of Server Boosting can provide.Tip: If youre a Nitro member, your subscription comes with two boosts you can use on any server. If you use both your boosts on an unboosted server, that server will gain ten additional sticker slots!If your server drops to a lower boosting tier while using your additional sticker slots, you wont be able to use any stickers that were uploaded after you hit your servers new sticker limit. You can choose whether or not you want to boost your server to regain access to those stickers, or start removing stickers until you reach your current limit.Stickers can be made out of your images, as long as you follow the upload requirements and follow our community guidelines. You dont have to be a professional artist to make a sticker for Discord!And honestly, some of the best stickers have that sort of slapped together with duct tape junk to em.If you simply want to crop your image and make it a sticker, you can likely stick to using your computers built-in editing software, such as Microsoft Paint on Windows and Preview on macOS. (Yes, we just linked Microsoft Paint as if it were some groundbreaking new app roll with it.)In addition, some Discord apps can automatically remove backgrounds from images posted in your conversations. Stickers are a cross between emojis and GIFs. It's a large image, often in a cartoon style, that expresses something. The concept of stickers isn't anything new. Messaging apps like iMessage and WhatsApp have offered stickers for years. There are even apps to turn yourself into a sticker. It's easy to use Discord stickers. The method slightly differs depending on device. On desktop: Select the sticker icon on the right side of the message field. It looks like a smiling square and is in the same section as the emoji and GIF icons. On mobile: Select the emoji icon on the right side of the message field. This opens the sticker interface. On the left (desktop) or bottom (mobile) is a list of all the servers you're in that has stickers to use, along with Discord's default sticker packs. The main pane shows the stickers. To send a sticker in chat, simply select it. The sticker sends as a standalone message. You need Discord Nitro (either the full version or Basic) to use stickers without restriction. As a free Discord user, you can use the default stickers anywhere, but can only use server-specific stickers in the server that hosts them. With Discord Nitro, you can use any sticker wherever you wish, including in DMs. If you run a server and don't want stickers from other servers used in yours, disable the Use External Stickers permission. To add custom stickers to Discord, you'll need to set up your own Discord server or have permissions in someone else's. The Create Expressions role allows someone to add stickers, and Manage Expressions allows for editing and deletion, though at the time of writing these permissions aren't available in all servers. Each server gets five free sticker slots. You can make your own stickers or use sites like stickers.gg to find some. To get more sticker slots, the server needs to be at a Boost level. Boosting adds new features to a Discord server, though it isn't free. The higher the server's Boost level, the more custom stickers you can upload. If the server drops a level, you lose access to the stickers occupying those extra slots. Including the five free slots, each Boost tier provides the following sticker slots: Level 1: 15 stickers total Level 2: 30 stickers total Level 3: 60 stickers total You can only add and manage a server's stickers on desktop.Android and iOS aren't supported. To do so: Navigate to the server. Click the server's name in the top-left. Click Server settings. From the left menu, click Stickers. Click Upload sticker. Upload the file for your sticker. It must be PNG (static) or APNG (animated), 512KB maximum, and exactly 320 x 320 pixels. To assist, Discord automatically resizes static PNGs. Give your sticker a name and choose a related emoji (this is so your sticker appears in Discord's sticker suggestion field.) Optionally, add a description to help those with screen readers. When you're happy with how it looks, click Upload. Once you've uploaded a sticker, click the pencil icon to edit it. However, you can only edit the sticker's information, not the sticker itself. If you want to replace the sticker, you should delete it and start again: press the red X icon to delete a sticker. If you want to quickly expand your Discord sticker collection, you should join other servers. Along with a Discord Nitro membership, you'll then have access to a range of stickers to use across your servers and DMs. Discord goes above and beyond when it comes to its interactive visual elements. From emojis that move to GIFs you can hide, there is never any shortage of customizable reactions. More recently, it reintroduced stickers, static or animated alternatives to emojis and GIFs. If you use WhatsApp and Instagram before, think of these like Discords own version of stickers. Heres how to add and use stickers on Discord.Stickers are somewhat of an enigma. Similar to GIFs, stickers are essentially just larger Discord emojis. Note that you cannot add them alongside text or to Discord statuses.Like emojis, custom stickers can be static images or animated. Nitro subscribers can use stickers on any server, not just a specific one.Discord users commonly use stickers to react to messages or greet others on servers. (Depending on your windows aspect ratio, you may see an actual Stickers icon here.)Click the Stickers category.From the extended menu, find the sticker you want to use.Select the sticker you want to use. When you insert the sticker, it will appear on your message line, and you wont be able to add any text.How to use Discord stickers on mobile:Open the Discord app on your device. If you dont have it, get it from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.Navigate to the server or direct message thread where you want to send the sticker.Tap the face emoji button to open the emoji tray.In the emoji tray, then press the Stickers tab.Find the sticker you want to use, then tap on it.If you want to add custom stickers, you must do so through your server. If the server isnt boosted, you can only add five custom stickers. This number grows as you reach higher levels. Reaching level one (two Boosts) will increase the quantity by 10 stickers. Reaching level two (seven Boosts) will increase the number of stickers by another 15. Level three requires 14 Boosts and can increase your Sticker count by 30, for a maximum of 60 custom stickers.How to add stickers to a Discord server on desktop:Launch the Discord desktop client or go to the Discord website and log in.Find your server in the left-hand column and right-click on it.Highlight Server Settings.From the server menu, click Stickersat the left pane.Within the Stickers tab, click theUpload Stickers button. A pop-up window will appear.On theUpload a file window, browse for the sticker you want to upload and fill in the details in the prompted box.Click theUpload button to finish the process.Even if your server is boosted to Level one or higher, you cannot upload custom stickers on the mobile app. Discord may add the ability to do so in a future app update.
